Your most valuable possessions deserve protection from fire or theft. They need the security that comes from using a safe deposit.

Do you own precious metals, jewellery, gemstones, paintings or valuable collections? What about important paperwork such as property titles and Wills? Many of these items are irreplaceable. Others are difficult to insure and often the premiums are higher than most people are willing to pay.

The Australian Executor Trustees Limited (AET) Safe Deposit Service is a cost-effective means of securely storing your valuables and personal papers.

Location

The AET Safe Deposit Service is situated in the basement of the Bank SA premises at 51 Pirie Street, Adelaide (corner of Gawler Place and Pirie Street). Entry is from Gawler Place.

Location

10.00am to 3.00pm, Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays).

To arrange a new rental no appointment is necessary, however we advise you to avoid the hours of 12.00pm to 1.00pm.

Safes

Safes are available in six different sizes. Annual rental rates vary according to the size of the safe.

For your security and privacy, two keys are required to open your safe:

- a cover-locking key which is retained by the Safe Deposit Manager, and
- a separate key held by you. This is the only one that will actually open the safe. (Duplicate keys are not held by the Safe Deposit Manager).

Large items

Our vault has a strong-room for the secure storage of items that will not fit into a safe deposit box.

Such items may include deed boxes, cases and trunks containing stamp or coin collections, computer disks, photographic albums, paintings and silverware. Annual rental rates vary according to the volume of storage space used.

Privacy

Tables and chairs are provided for your use within our vault. For clients requiring absolute privacy separate and secure rooms are also available.

Rental conditions

Rental agreements are for 12 months and can be arranged by an individual who will have sole access, or by a number of people with joint or individual access rights. Deputy signatories may be authorised to act on your behalf but with limited rights.

All persons authorised to access a safe deposit box or safe custody lodgement are required by law to undergo an identification process similar to opening a bank account.

Goods and services tax

All fees and rates quoted are inclusive of GST.
